This is very important to minimize the loading time and to maintain the quality of the image. All types of images can be converted, including those from the camera, scans, etc. Search and opening Photoshop The program used for image preparation is Adobe Photoshop. If you are on a Macintosh it just clicks on the Photoshop icon at the bottom of the screen, as shown in the image below. If not there, go to Applications > Photoshop. If you are on Windows, click on the "Start" menu at the bottom left of the screen. Locate the "Adobe" folder and select "Photoshop CS-2 Start". Back to the top Create the correct image size Get the correct image size is the first step. The size of the current screen is. Using this information as a reference, to understand how big you want to show the image on the screen. Once you have a general idea for the size of the image, a look at the DPI guide to understand what dpi you want to acquire the image at. With the image open in Photoshop, go to the "Image" menu and Select "Image size...". The Image Size window will open. Here you can set the image to any size you want. By deselecting "Keep proportions" will allow greater freedom over the image size, but with the risk of looking disproportionate. Prepare images for the web when creating images for web use, keeping the low size of the file is very important. To achieve this goal, the size and compression levels must be taken into consideration. The most commonly used formats for web images are GIF and JPG. These formats offer low file size and moderate to very high quality. GIF is commonly used for simple illustrations, while JPEG is commonly used for photographs. With your open image in Adobe Photoshop, go to the "File" menu and select "Save for Web". It will open "Save for Web" window. If you work with a photo, the JPEG file format is suggested. If it is a graph, such as a banner, logo or navigation tool, GIF format is suggested. To use the JPEG format, select JPEG in the menu. With JPEG, it is important to note the size of the image file to minimize the load time. If it's too high, reduce quality. Click the "Save" button when you're done. To save the image in GIF format select the following options in the settings menu. Play with the color setting, less less The smaller colors the image will be. Use the color table to remove all redundant colors; You can delete colors directly from the color table. In order to delete a color from the color table, select the color you want to delete and then click on the Recycle Bin icon. Watch for changes in the image size of your optimized image. When you have finished clicking OK and save the image. Your image is now ready web. Back to Start Preparing images for printing When preparing images for printing, high quality images are desired. The ideal size selection for printing is TIFF, followed by NP from PNG. With your open image in Adobe Photoshop, go to the "File" menu and select "Save As". The "Save As" window will open. Select the format you want to use for the image and click "Save". Your image is printed time ready.
