MacDill Air Force Base, Florida is an Air Mobility Command located just 10 miles from The area is a military-friendly community and is located on the south-western part of Interbay Interbay This Air Force base has four groups responsible for fuel supply and air support to unified controls hosted at the base: United States Central Command and Special Command of Special Operations. The construction began in September 1939 and was formally dedicated in April 1941 as a field of MacDill. Colonel Leslie MacDill was a World War a pilot who was killed in an AirCrash in 1938. MacDill is nominated in his honor. In 1939, the U.S. War Department had serious concerns about shipping lane issues associated with U-Boat Nazi attacks in areas such as the Gulf of Mexico. When the flight line opened for business at the base, MacDill became part of the U.S. defense strategy in the Gulf of Mexico. Another activity of the Second World War in MacDill involved something known as the X project, which included shipping routes to deliver fighter aircraft to strengthen troops in the Philippines. MacDill was responsible for sending aircraft from 15 LB-30 and 63 B-17 during this period. Once America was firmly involved in World War II, MacDill played an important role in the formation of bombing equipment. Once the Second World War has ended, many U.S. bases would change the missions, becoming re-aligned or experimenting shortMacDill was not immune to this; The B-29 driving training has been scaled back, and MacDill has been used to help bring back the transition of Bomber groups to peace operations. SAC, then TAC, then MacDill on the chopping board block in 1946, the Continental Air control was redesigned as Strategic Air Control (SAC), which later caused the activation of the Bombardment group as a guest unit of MacDill Field. In 1962 the MacDill AFB passed from the SAC to the Tactical Air Command (TAC) and the mission of bombers passed to the McCoy AFB. It was then that the 310th Airlift Squadron (310 AS) was activated at the base, supporting both the United States Southern Command (USSouthcom) and the Central Command (USCentcom) A 2008 Brac decision saw the 927th Air Refueling Wing (927 ARW) move from the Selfridge Air National Guard Base, Mich to the MacDill AFB. Today, MacDill’s aerial base is an Air Mobility command base that supports global air transport and air supply worldwide missions.
