The Great Heathen Army, spearheaded by legendary leaders like Ivar the Boneless and Guthrum, swept through East Anglia in 865, conquering York (Jorvik) and establishing a Danish stronghold. This marauding force eventually subjugated Northumbria and most of Mercia, leaving only Wessex under the leadership of Alfred the Great as a bastion of resistance.The Viking expansion also reached the shores of Ireland, where monasteries were frequently raided for their riches. The Danes set up impermanent camps called longphorts, leading to a period known as the longphort phase. This era saw Ireland organized into small kingdoms (tuatha) often ruled by a provincial leader, who might be granted the title of High King if they could consolidate power over several tuatha.Scotland was also ravaged by Viking incursions, with settlements established in northern regions and islands like Orkney and Shetland. This influx contributed significantly to the decline of the Pictish kingdoms, leading to Kenneth MacAlpin's movement from DI Riata to the east, where he conquered the remnants of Pictish realms, becoming the first King of Alba.Artistic endeavors during this period primarily focused on liturgical pieces for the Roman Catholic Church, such as golden reliquaries and crucifixes. Architecture began to revive with the construction of simple castles like "moat and bailey" forts or tower structures.Meanwhile, in other parts of the world:- The Khmer Empire was founded by Jayavarman II in Cambodia.- Construction on the Leshan Giant Buddha in Tang dynasty China completed after 90 years.- War between the Byzantine empire and Bulgaria took place from 809815.- Arab naval raids plagued the shores of Tyrrehanian and Adriatic seas.The year 814 marked a turning point as Charlemagne passed away, leading to a new era of peace agreements, including a 30-year pact between Bulgaria and the Byzantine Empire in 815.A mathematician wrote a book on algebra called The Compendious Book on Calculation by Completion and Balancing in year 824. King Egbert defeated Mercia and made Wessex a superior Kingdom in England at that time. Another important building, Borobudur, was finished during the Samaratungga's reign in 825, which is believed to have started around 800.The Aghlabids created an emirate in Sicily and attacked Southern Italy from 827-902. The Ghana Empire appeared in year 830, as did a library called House of Wisdom in Baghdad that transferred knowledge from Greeks, Persians, Indians and others to the Muslim world. Al-Khwarizmi wrote his algebra book there.The Sweet Dew Incident occurred in 835 when Emperor Wenzong tried to kill some powerful eunuchs but failed. Zacharias III sent an envoy with his son Georgios I to Baghdad and was able to lower their slave payments from 400 to 200 for three years. Vlastimir defeated Presian between 839-842, while Louis the Pious died in year 840.Dublin was founded by Vikings on the east coast of Ireland in 841, followed by Samaale's conquest of Somalia in year 842. The Carolingian Empire reached its peak during this time with three sons splitting it among themselves in year 843. Buddhism was banned in China in 845 and Emperor Xuanzong reigned until 859.The Saracen Arabs desecrated Christian shrines in Rome, including those of Sts Peter and Paul, in 846, but then built a defensive wall around the city in year 848. The first Norse settlers arrived on Iceland in 850-875 and the Muslim Berber dynasty Banu Isam was founded in Ceuta during this period.The ninth century was a time of great change and development in various parts of the world. In Wessex, Great Britain, the region was at its peak during this period, with Iceland settling under Ingolfur Arnarson from Norway in 872. Meanwhile, in China, Huang Chao led an unsuccessful rebellion against the Tang dynasty between 875-884.The year 878 saw a significant battle take place at Ethandun, where Alfred the Great emerged victorious over the Danish warlord Guthrum. The arrival of disciples from Saints Cyril and Methodius brought the development of the Cyrillic Alphabet to Bulgaria, marking an important milestone in the country's cultural heritage.In other regions, Abbo Cernuus witnessed the Siege of Paris by Vikings in 885. The Carolingian Empire's decline began after Charles the Fat's death in 888, leading to its eventual fall. In Bulgaria, Prince Vladimir-Rasate was dethroned and succeeded by Simeon I, who moved the capital from Pliska to Preslav.This period also saw significant events in other parts of the world, including the arrival of the Magyars in Pannonia around 895/896, marking the beginning of the Hungarian "Landtaking". The reign of King Alfred the Great came to an end with his death in 899. Additionally, the Laguna copperplate inscription was discovered on a copperplate in Luzon, Philippines, in 900.The late ninth century witnessed several notable developments, including the stretching of Bulgaria's territory from the Danube to Epirus and Bosnia, as well as the Pallava dynasty's end in Southern India. The Heian period in Japan began, with Charlemagne reigning over Western Europe and a concurrent Carolingian Renaissance taking place.Large-scale Viking attacks began on Europe during this time, devastating many people. The Magyars started their conquest of Pannonia, while Muslim traders settled in the northwest and southeast of Madagascar. In Italy, some cities became free republics, such as Forl, in 889.The Christian Nubian kingdom reached its peak in prosperity and military power during this period. Harald Fairhair was victorious at the Battle of Hafsford, unifying Norway into a single kingdom. The Medieval Warm Period started, and the Coptic period ended.Significant advancements were made in science and technology as well, including the development of algebra by Al-Khwarizmi, the derivation of quadratic equations by Indian mathematician rdharcrya, and the invention of gunpowder by Chinese Taoist alchemists. The first image of a rotary grindstone appeared in a European source, while the Diamond Sutra was printed in China using woodblock printing.Chess reached Japan, and two syllabaries or kana were developed from simplified Chinese characters. The Tibetan Script underwent its third and last orthographical reform during this time. The majority of the students are from California, with Sunny Hills High School being one of the top 323 schools in the state.###ARTICLEStudent Retention and Disability DataA total of 118 students were enrolled in LEAP programs, comprising 52 Hispanics, 64 Asians, and 2 Whites. Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) accounted for 22 students.Students with disabilities received special education services under IDEA, while those served under Section 504 had limited English proficiency and were not eligible for IDEA services.In the 9th grade, 86 students were retained, with 46 Hispanics, 2 Asians, and 34 Whites being among them. The retention rate varied across states, ranging from 5.9% at Sunny Hills High School to 16.7% in California.Gifted and Talented Student Enrollment: A Look at DiversityThe enrollment numbers for gifted and talented students in Sunny Hills High School reveal a diverse student body. With 1,358 students enrolled, the breakdown by ethnicity shows a significant Hispanic presence (16.3%), followed closely by Asian students (83.9%).
